# GO-OH SHINTO SHRINE



#### Introduction

- Go-oh Shrine is located in Kyoto on the western side of the Imperial Palace.
- It is dedicated to all things relating to boar. In place of the usual Komainu (mythical lion-like beasts) standing guard outside the shrine, a pair of wild boar have been erected.
- Wake no Kinomaru (733–799), an adviser to the Heian Period Emperor Kammu (737–806), and the courtier's sister Hiromushi are enshrined at Go-oh.
