Ceremony Details

- ▶ Guests: Maximum 40 people
- ▶ [Ceremony fee - 150,000 yen]
- ▶ Only two ceremonies per day.
AM (10:00 or 11:00) or PM (14:00 or 15:00)
- ▶ [Unavailable days]
Not fixed.
Depends on the temple's schedule.

Introduction

- ▶ Kodai-ji Temple is located northeast of Yasaka Hokanji Temple at the foot of the Higashiyama Ryozen Mountains in Kyoto.
- ▶ It was established in 1606 by Kita-no-Mandokoro (1548-1624) in memory of her husband Toyotomi Hideyoshi (1536-1598).
- ▶ The Temple Garden is said to have been designed by the landscape garden designer Kobori Enshu (1579-1647) and is designated by the Japanese Government as a historical site and a place of scenic beauty.
